Identifying a champion within the group and leveraging their influence to solicit buy-in from their peers is always necessary.

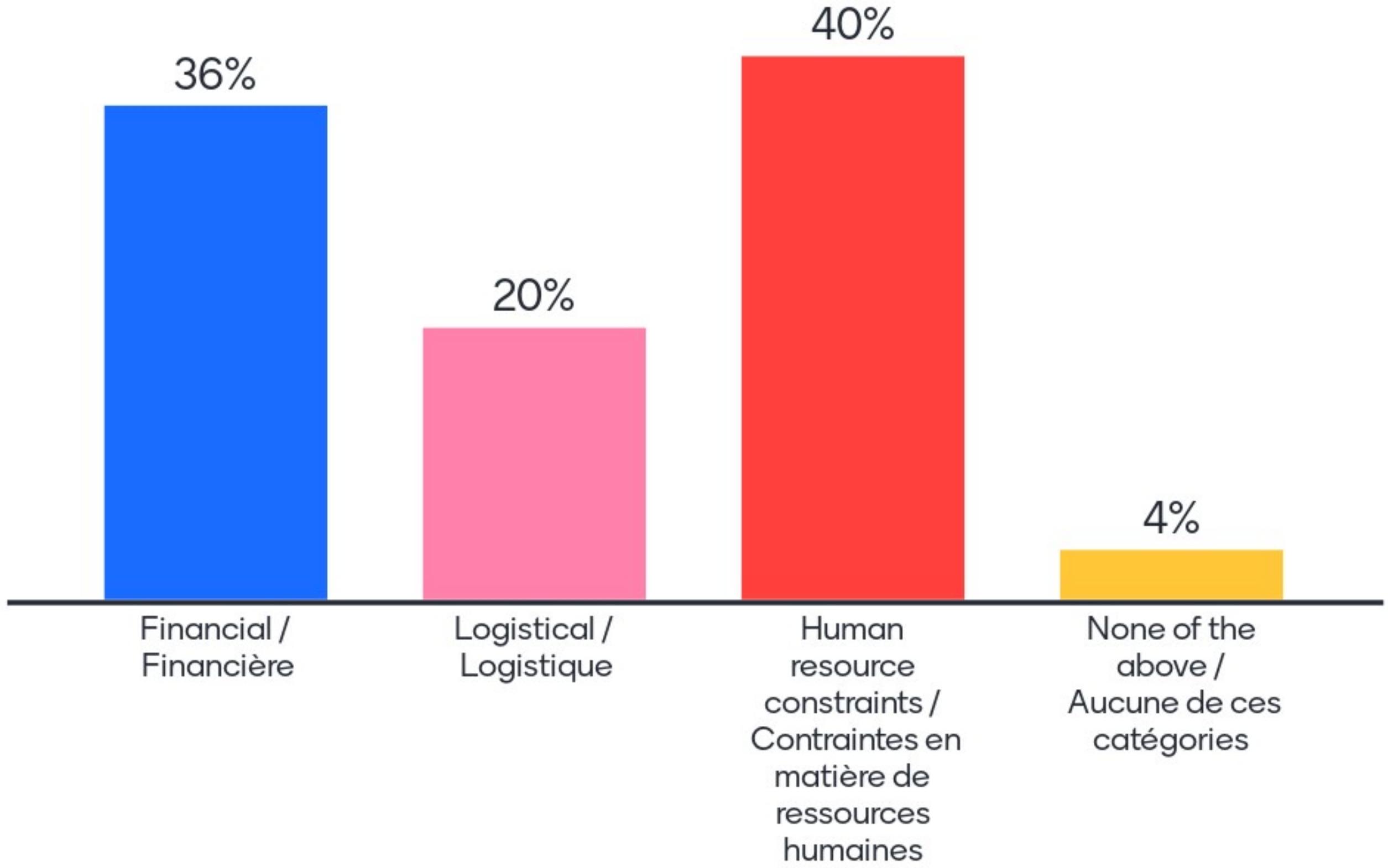

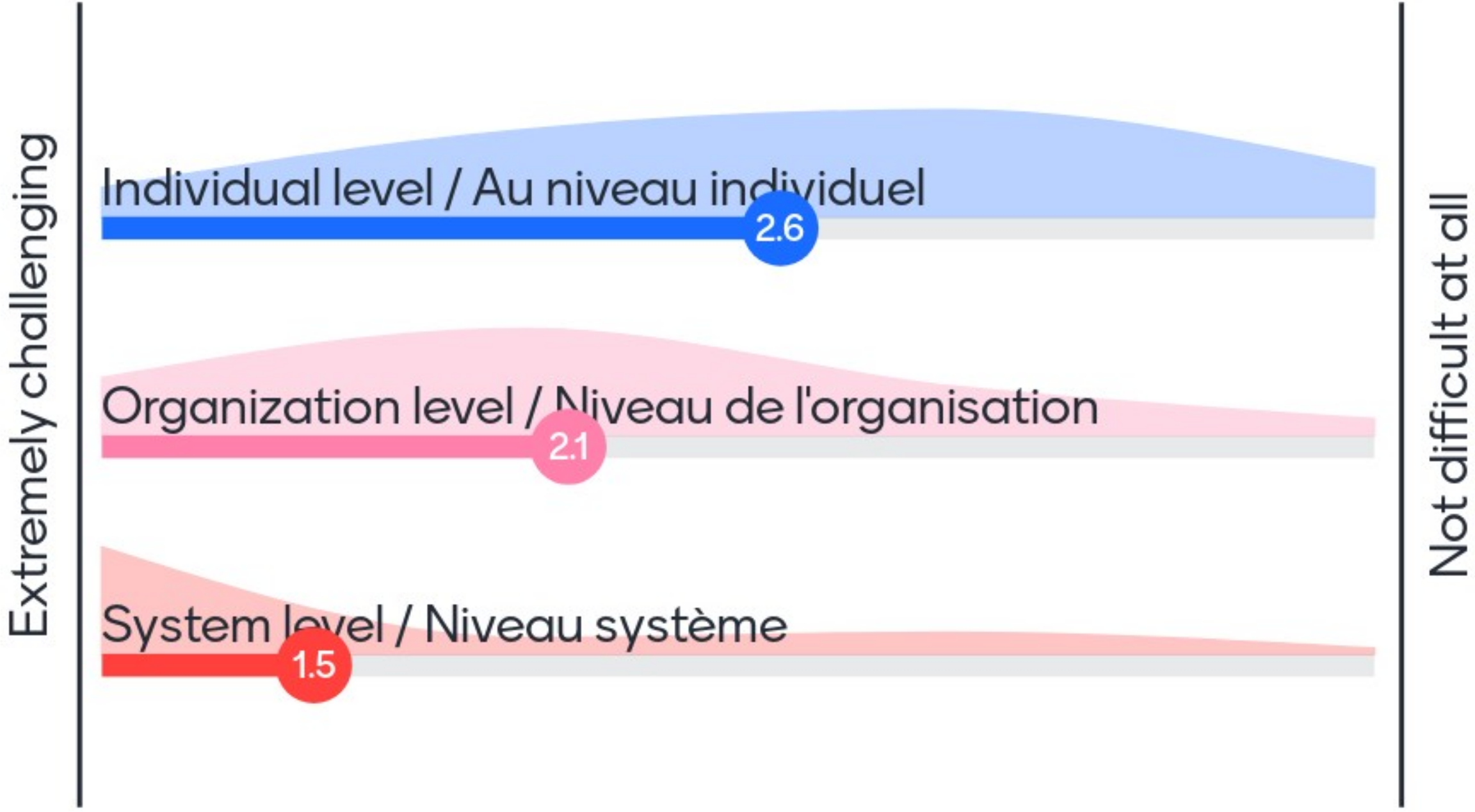
There are no mechanims to continue support to communities after project ends
