# Mosquitoes and Ladders



## How to play the game!

1. The game is played using a single dice, dice cup and four coloured game pieces. It can be played by a minimum of two players and a maximum of four players.
2. Each player MUST roll a "6" to begin movement on the game (roll a '6', then roll the dice again to move. E.g., If a player rolls a 6, then rolls a 5, he/she moves to number 5 box)
3. Successive rolls are used to move along the board till a player gets to the last square "60".
4. When a player lands on any red box with the mosquito, the player slides down to the proboscis of the mosquito and reads aloud the caption in the box. They also read aloud the caption in the box they land on.
5. A player climbs up the ladder when they land on the foot of the ladder in the green boxes, they read aloud the caption at the foot of the ladder before climbing up.
6. The first player to overcome all obstacles and get to box "60" wins the game. The number rolled MUST get the player to exactly '60' to win the game. (for example, if a player is on box '58' he/she MUST roll a dice to get the number '2' and win the game.
